

## Applicants applying for Registered Practitioner and holding legacy assessor credentials

Applicants with D32 and D33 units, or A1 and A2 units have a notional equivalence of the Award in Assessing Competence in the Work Environment (ACWE). This means that the Assessors Guild professional standards shaded out below are automatically evidenced if you can show proof of certification and that these assessor qualifications underpin your current assessment practice, allowing you to assess.

This means that your application information needs to focus on the professional standards that are not automatically addressed by your assessor credentials. You also need to ensure that these legacy credentials are your active assessment credentials, i.e. these are underpinning your current assessment practice.
